Minutes of the meeting of the 12th Academic Council of KLS Gogte Institute of Technology held on 14th August, 2021 at 11.30 am


12.1	Compliance of 11th Academic Council meeting resolution
	<p>Preamble : Dean Academics presented the Compliance Status for Resolutions of 11th Academic Council Meeting</p> <p>Decision: The members approved the compliance report. However, the members expressed that the compliance of activities in progress if any, from the earlier resolutions could also included.</p>
12.2	Extension of Autonomous status
	<p>Preamble: The members were informed about</p> <p>(i) The extension of autonomous status given by UGC and VTU for 10 years from 2021-22 to 2030-31.</p> <p>(ii) AICTE-CIE survey conducted for the industry linked technical institute for having more interaction and connectivity with the industry. The institute has been included in the platinum category under AICTE-CIE survey.</p> <p>(iii) The members were also informed about various ranking given by magazines such as India Today, Outlook, Career 360 and Times Engineering.</p> <p>The academic council members congratulated the institute and the entire team of the college for the achievement. The members suggested to analyse the short comings and prepare the plan to overcome the short comings.</p>
12.3	Academic Report for 2020-21
	<p>Preamble: Dean Academics presented the academic calendar of Odd and Even semester of 2020-21.</p> <p>The members were also appraised about online mode of content delivery and evaluation. They were informed that online mode of teaching was adopted during the Odd sem as college was closed due to pandemic. The even semester began in the month of December-2020 with offline classes, but, due to 2nd COVID wave the lockdown was announced. Therefore, the teaching learning was through online again.</p> <p>Regarding the evaluation, the COE informed that offline examinations were conducted for the Odd semester. During the Even semester offline examination for theory courses and viva-voce for projects were conducted for final year. As per the guidelines, the intermediate semester students are promoted.</p> <p>The members were pleased to know about the academic activities. Members also appreciated the faculty members for their efforts for the online teaching.</p>
12.4	Alumni Engagement Report
	<p>Preamble: Principal appraised the members about the participation of the alumni in the academic activities. The report of the various activities having alumni engagement was presented.</p> <p>The academic council members were happy to know about the involvement of alumni in the academic activities such as Webinar, Internship, Personal development and Placements. They appreciated the alumni for sparing their time and involvement in the institute activities. Member mentioned that such activities will help to connect the institute and alumni.</p>

12.6	Accreditation Report
	Preamble: The members were informed that the NBA accreditation was valid upto 30.06.2021. The institute has submitted the prequalifier for five UG programs and SAR for the two M.Tech program. Response from NBA is awaited. Regarding NAAC, the validity of NAAC is till December-2021, the action plan is being prepared for submitting IIQA and SSR. Members were requested for approving the submission of application. Decision: Members advised to make the proper preparation for the NBA visit. The proposal for submitting the NAAC accreditation was approved.

	Preamble: Principal appraised about the various activities being conducted for implementation of NEP-2020 in the institute. Decision: The members expressed their happiness about preparation. They advised to plan the activities as initial phase of implementation of NEP is very challenging due to complexity involved such as Academic Base of Credits and multiple entry and exit policy.
