Note for Applicants :

1. The Call for Proposal will be rolled out every year in the month of March. However, this time it is in the November '2024.
2. Process of Approval is Subject to the GC & BOM meeting and tentative approval will be in the month of December '2024.
3. The approval amount should be spent in the approved financial year for non-recurring. Recurring expenses could be carried to next year (if necessary). Maximum tenure for seed amount scheme project outcome is two years from the date of approval. Failing to project the promised outcome is brought to the notice of RRC followed by GC for necessary action.
4. Review of the progress will be done by RRC Committee. Further, the report of the RRC is submitted to the GC. GC'S decision is final.
5. The seed amount Scheme could be availed once in 5years by the faculty subject to the approval of the committee.
